On Thursday 28th June, the Year 6 children attended a transition morning at St Paul's Academy that is aimed at helping them prepare for

the changes that will take place when they start at their various secondary schools. During this event, the children took part in a number of different activities focusing on use of public transport and expectations for secondary schools.

Boxgrove Attendance Awards

Also on Tuesday 17th July, we had our termly attendance celebration assembly for the children, where we also gave out awards to those children who had attended school for every day this year. The termly attendance awards are where we recognise those children who have achieved our gold, silver or bronze attendance awards for the term. There were 148 children who had not had a day off from school for the whole of the Summer term and they achieved a gold attendance award. Three of these children were also chosen at random and they won Sainsbury's vouchers. There were also a total of 45 children who had not had a single day off throughout this whole school year (from September 2017). They were awarded a medal for 100% attendance this academic year or a trophy for 100% attendance and



punctuality. Next year, at the end of the year, children with 100% attendance will be put into a prize draw to win one of three scooters. We also recognised the attendance of Arielle from Year 3, who has not had any time off school in the last 4 years. Well done to all of those children and especially to Arielle.
