Gates in the Morning

As always, there will be senior leaders present on the gates and in the playground at the beginning and end of each day. This is a great opportunity to catch us if there is any information you need to pass on. When the bell goes at 9 am the main gate onto Boxgrove Road closes in order to allow the children in Reception to get safely into their classrooms. Please remember if you would like to leave the playground as soon as the bell goes, please leave via the side gate through the staff car park. If you would prefer to leave through the main gate, you will need to wait on the playground until all the children are in their classes and the gate has reopened. This also means that parents of Reception children don't need to walk down with their classes as they will be able to see that they are safely in their classroom before the gate reopens. Hopefully this will allow all children to safely and calmly make their way into class and allow parents to leave the school site quickly and easily. Your co-operation in this matter is greatly appreciated.

Uniform Prices

It is wonderful to see all of the children looking so smart in their Boxgrove School Uniforms. Children will be regularly awarded house points throughout the year for wearing their correct school uniform. There has been a slight increase to the cost of Boxgrove uniform available at the office. The new prices are as follows:

Please remember, we do ask your child wears either a Boxgrove jumper or cardigan, but we are happy for you to purchase any of the other items needed from supermarkets or clothing stores. In case your child misplaces any item of their uniform, please ensure every item has their name on a label, so we can efficiently return items to you. Uniform can be ordered and paid for via ParentMailX®.

ParentMailX

New parents to the school (and those parents who have not registered), will shortly receive a link to register for ParentMailX®. Please register as soon as possible to ensure that you receive all communications from the school.

All communications to parents are sent via email or text via ParentMailX®. A summary of all communications sent, listed by year group, is posted on the Parents' Board every Friday afternoon. This enables you to check that have not missed any communications sent. If you have missed any, copies can be requested from the Office.

ParentMailX® also enables parents to:

- Report their children's absence from school due to unexpected illness/events
- Give parental permission for children to attend trips (see forms section)
- Pay for lunches/clubs/trips/school uniform
- Book parent evening appointments

If any parents would like help with ParentMail® registration, please make an appointment with the school office.

School Meals

We would like to remind our parents that school meals cost £10 a week. We request that school meals are paid in advance – this can be done using the ParentMail system outlined above.

Medication

As we start the new academic year, please remember to bring in any prescribed medication your child might need. All medication must have a prescription label on it and come in through the school office as there is some paperwork you need to complete before we can legally give it to your child in school. Any queries, speak to the school office or a senior leader.

Parking

Parking near the school is severely limited and most of our families live very close by, so if at all possible please walk your child to and from school. If you do need to drive, please park your car responsibly, making sure you are not blocking driveways, or parking on private property. Your co-operation is greatly appreciated as when people park illegally, it makes the area more dangerous for our parents and children, as well as disrupting local residents.
