Our Topic

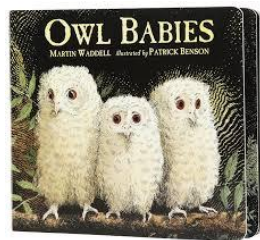

Settling in

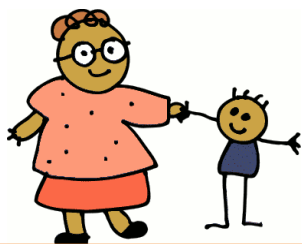
