

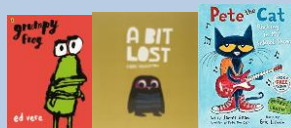
Boxgrove Reception News Autumn 1

Topics

Each half term we will have a different topic to focus our learning around. This half term our topic will be 'Me and those who help me'.

To help support this topic we will use the following books to motivate and engage the children to support their learning; 'Grumpy Frog', 'A Bit Lost', 'Pete the Cat Rocking my New Shoes', 'Harry and the Dinosaurs go to School', and 'I am too small for School'.



In maths we will be focusing on the different areas of Number, for example counting and recognising numerals. We will then move on to Shape where we will look at common 2D shapes and their properties, for example 'a triangle has 3 sides'.

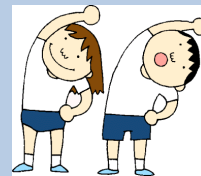
Trips
