Welcome back!

We hope you all had a fantastic summer and we welcome you back to this new academic year! We hope you are refreshed after the break and ready for a fun and exciting year of learning.

Creative Curriculum

Our new topic for this half term is Extreme Earth. Within this topic, we will be focusing on geography skills. This will include: looking at natural disasters, the reasons they happen, the cause of the disaster and the impact they have on the environment. By the end of the half term, the children will write an information text about natural disasters, and they will build a replica of a volcano and use cross curricular skills to make it explode!

Science

Our topic in science is properties and changes of materials. We will provide children with opportunities to understand the changes a material goes through such as chemical reactions, how these reactions are used in daily scenarios and experiment how to separate fluids and solids.

Computing

As part of our computing topic, we will focus on developing the children's web design skills to create a website based on their research of natural disasters. The children will learn many key aspects to creating a website such as: altering the design, inserting digital media and menu bars and links to refer you to other pages. They will also be using these websites to inform the public about the natural disasters they have researched.

Mathematics

We will continue to do work on 'calculations', 'space and shape', 'data handling' and 'problems solving' in mathematics. This term we will cover addition and subtraction of numbers with five or more digits, equivalent fractions as well as learning key vocabulary that could include multiples, factors and prime numbers.

English

This term we will be focusing on writing a narrative story. To allow the children to become effective authors in this genre, we will be studying the text 'Floodland' by Marcus Sedgwick. This will provide a high level example of what is expected within this topic. By the end of the unit, the children will have written their own narrative story based on a child being reunited with their family after a natural disaster.
