English

In English, we will be looking at the Roald Dahl Classic—'The BFG'. The Big Friendly Giant is one of Roald Dahl's best-loved characters. From this, we will then re-write our own imaginative version of the story in the style of Roald Dahl. Finally, we will write an explanation text to support our science learning about forces and magnets.

Maths

During maths this half term, we will look at telling the time with increasing accuracy, using 12-hour and 24-hour clocks. We will explore shape further, looking at 2D and 3D shapes, as well as angles. We will then move on to interpreting and presenting data in different forms, including bar charts and tables. We will also be solving problems involving fractions.

Science

In science, we will be investigating forces, with a particular focus on magnets and their properties. We will conduct experiments to assess which materials are attracted to magnets, explore and develop key vocabulary to describe forces and produce scientific reports based on our findings.



Creative

This half term we are focusing on 'Modern Mosaics'. The children will explore examples of mosaics and visit the Southbank for a mosaic walk, before creating their own mosaic tiles. As part of computing, the children will be following, creating and debugging algorithms to draw shapes with Pro-bots!

PE

We will be developing our co-ordination, balance and movement skills through the exploration of dance. The children will then choreograph their own dance sequences. All children need the following PE kit on Mondays and Thursdays: white t-shirt, black or navy bottoms, trainers or plimsolls.
