

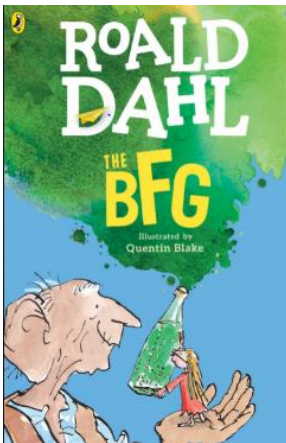
Year 3 - Autumn 2

Learning

This half term all of our English and creative learning will be based on Roald Dahl's classic novel, *The BFG*. The children will be writing their own versions of *The BFG* and producing a mosaic to accompany this.



In this term we have many exciting activities planned for each of the subjects.

Computing – In computing we will be using Pro-bots to program an algorithm.

Science – In science this term, we will be looking at fossils and soils. We will produce replica fossils and carry out investigations to compare the properties of different soil types.
